Summary of March 30, 2025 St. John's Lutheran Church Pearl City, IL Holy Conversation

Our Attendance was 45 Summary compiled from written and verbal responses.

- 1. We look to pastors to be compassionate, caring, empathetic.
- 2. One of our struggles is that we fail to talk to the pastor directly about a concern we might have, or to a fellow member if we have a concern with them (Matthew 18), and not let things fester personally, or in small groups
- 3. Come to an understanding that when dealing with pastoral concerns the following steps are important.
 - a. Go to the pastor him or herself first if not resolved.
 - b. Take the concern to the Mutual Ministry Committee, if not resolved.
 - c. Take the next step and bring the matter to the Council.
 - d. If unresolved, the council needs to bring the matter to the attention of the synod

The synod typically does not deal with individual pastoral complaints.

- 4. Broaden Christian Education and Faith Formation for all ages.
- 5. It's God's Church. God has given the church a Mission. We are called by the Spirit to identify that mission for our congregation. We are empowered as pastor and people to accomplish this mission together.
