**Sunday, September 14** is the beginning of our Christian Education Year, as we rally together to begin our faith formation with classes for children, youth and adult.

Sunday School will be held each Sunday for our children, which will begin with a Children's Message in the Sanctuary and then will continue with classroom activities until the Greeting of Peace when children will join their families in time for communion.
